Pemerintah Republik Indonesia memberikan kesempatan para pemuda Afrika Selatan untuk mempelajari seni dan kebudayaan Indonesia dalam program kursus jangka pendek melalui Program Beasiswa Seni dan Budaya Indonesia tahun 2012.

Beasiswa Seni dan Budaya Indonesia adalah program non-gelar yang dilakukan dalam periode 14 minggu, mulai tanggal 31 Maret - 13 Juli 2012. Peserta akan diseleksi oleh panitia ke 5 (lima) pusat seni yang berada di Bandung, Solo, Surabaya, Denpasar dan Makassar (tentative). Di sanggar-sanggar tersebut, para penerima anugerah akan dikenalkan pada seni dan budaya Indonesia khususnya seni dan budaya masing-masing daerah, Bahasa Indonesia dan bahasa lokal setempat, studi ekskursi ke tempat-tempat bersejarah dan tempat wisata, serta dilibatkan dalam berbagai promosi seni budaya dan pariwisata di masing-masing daerah.

Beasiswa meliputi biaya kuliah (termasuk kegiatan ekstra-kurikuler), tiket perjalanan pulang-pergi kelas ekonomi, akomodasi (tempat penginapan), asuransi kesehatan, uang saku bulanan (3 bulan) **sebesar Rp. 1.500.000,-**, biaya perpanjangan izin tinggal (2 kali) dan biaya *airport tax* di Indonesia. Program beasiswa mengharuskan calon sebaiknya berusia antara usia 21 sampai 30 tahun, latar belakang pendidikan minimal lulus Sekolah Menengah Atas, mempunyai kesehatan yang baik (dibuktikan dengan surat keterangan dokter), dan memiliki minat dan bakat dalam seni. Mahasiswa seni atau mereka yang mempunyai pengalaman dalam seni budaya Indonesia didorong untuk mengikuti program beasiswa ini.

Pelamar harus menyerahkan formulir beasiswa pendaftaran lengkap dengan salinan transkrip akademik, sertifikat medis (keterangan dokter), salinan paspor yang masih berlaku dan 3 (tiga) lembar pas foto, selambat-lambatnya pada tanggal 15 Februari 2012 kepada Konsulat Jenderal Republik Indonesia di Cape Town.

The Government of the Republic of Indonesia gives the opportunity for young South Africans to study various subjects of arts and culture in short term courses programme through the 2011 Indonesian Arts and Culture Scholarship Programme.

The Indonesian Arts and Culture Scholarship is a non-degree program undertaken within 14 weeks period of time, starting on the 31st of March to the 13th of July 2012. Participants will be divided and assigned by the organising committee to different arts centers at 5 (five) cities, located in Bandung, Solo, Surabaya, Denpasar and Makassar (tentative). In the art centers, awardees will be introduced to the arts and cultures of Indonesia, especially arts and cultures of each region, Indonesian languages (Bahasa), and local/ethnic languages. Excursion study to historic places and tourist attractions, and variety of promotional events of art, culture, and tourism in each region will also be the part of the scholarship program.

The scholarship covers tuition fees (including extra-curricular activities), a round trip economy-class ticket, accommodation (board and lodging), health insurance, and monthly allowance of Rp.1.500.000,-, cost of extension of stay (2 times) and the cost of airport tax in Indonesia. The scholarship program requires candidates to be aged between 21 to 30 years old with at least a high school diploma, to be in good condition of health (proven by medical certificate), and to have interest and talent in arts. Arts students or those with an academic history on Indonesian culture are encouraged to apply.

The applicants should submit the completed scholarship application forms together with the copy of academic transcript, medical certificate (doctor's statement), the copy of valid passport and 5 (three) pieces of ID photos by no later than 15 February 2012 to the Consulate General of the Republic of Indonesia.
